

School Lunch Program

Free and reduced price lunches are available to children who meet certain requirements. All schools are required to serve meals at no charge to children whose household income is at or below 130% of the federal poverty guidelines. Children are entitled to pay a reduced price if their household income is above 130% but below 185% of these guidelines. Children are automatically eligible for free meals if their household receives food stamps, benefits under the Food Distribution Program on Indian Reservations or, the child receives benefits under Utah's Family Employment Program.
